Now, in Hebrews the 11th chapter, or 12th chapter, the 1st verse, it said: ... seeing we... are compassed about with such a great cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every <u>sin</u>, and the--the... weight, and the sin that... so easily beset us....

Now, we realize that SIN only one thing; that's unbelief. Sin is in the singular. Sins... You are a sinner because you are an unbeliever. You are a Christian because you are a believer. It doesn't mean now one time, or... Many times I've said that smoking, drinking, gambling, and committing adultery, lying, that isn't sin; that's the attributes of unbelief. That's what unbelief produces. That's the reason you do it is because you're an unbeliever. But when you become a believer, then all of these things shed off, and it's a new life of belief; and it produces righteousness, peace, joy, love, longsuffering, goodness, patience, gentleness. That's the attributes, because you are a believer.

Eve stopped for a moment. That's all she had to do. Satan had her caught and just reasoned it with her. "Isn't it reasonable? If Sister So-and-so can do that, can't you do it too? She's the pastor's wife." I don't care who she is, or who he is. If it's contrary to the Word, don't you listen to it. Go straight on. Examples...

God promised Abraham through Sarah to have this child. But now watch, the first seed of Abraham by the bondswoman come by Sarah doubting that this could happen, because she was old and passed the age of bearing. Now, that's how the church starts. Isaac being the seed of the free and promised woman, brought forth (as Paul was trying to explain here in Galatians) he brought forth the natural, promised seed. You just, you're not heirs together; neither will you--will you join with it. You cannot do it. You've got to be eagle or a chicken.

And lot of times, **our unbelief would destroy us**, **if it wasn't for the Blood of Jesus Christ**. God can't destroy us now, because the Blood of Jesus Christ keeps the--God off of us. We are part of Christ, just as Sarah was part of Abraham, for we are the Bride of Christ.

"The Word of God is sharper, more powerful than a two-edged sword, cutting even to the marrow of the bone, and a Discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." Christ, "The works that I do shall you also." See Him doing that. How many seen Him do it? Sure, we know He does it. He lives here. He's in our hearts. They don't believe it. They didn't believe it then, they don't believe it now. They believe He died and that settled it, and we got some kind of a historical thing...

Now, go back to prophecy. What a rebuke for believers, claimed they believed Him. Notice how He approached the subject.

He never come right out and said, "I am your Messiah." He could've done it, for He was. But notice; **He identified Himself in the Word, then they would know**. If He'd have said it, He could've said that and it wouldn't have been so; but when He went and begin to speak on all the prophets said about Him, and they seen it, then they could tell themselves, if they were God's children. But called their attention to what the prophets had foretold and said to look for in the time that the Messiah, His age would be manifested. He, as John, let the Word, the Bible identify their message. Any true prophet would do it. Sure. He didn't come out and say, "I am He. I'm..." That's not a true prophet of God. See? But He said, "Go back in the Scriptures." See, He never fails His way of doing it. See?

He said, "We know Moses."

He said, "If you would've knowed Moses, you'd know Me." He said, "Moses wrote of Me." Said, "Search the Scripture, in Them you think you have Eternal Life, and the Scripture is what testifies of Me. Go and look in the Scripture and see it." Here He never changes His way of doing it, never has changed. He never can change, because He's the unchanging God. See? Notice, He went right back to these two disciples, Cleopas and his friend, on the road to Emmaus, and

said, appealed to the Scriptures to them, said, "Why are you so foolish to not to believe that every Word the prophets wrote concerning the Messiah would have to be fulfilled?" Oh, what a day. John did the same thing. "Search the Scriptures; look back, said there'd be a voice of one crying in the wilderness. Where did I come from? See?" That's... That should've made it plain to them. Right. It should make it plain today, the thing that we see the Holy Spirit doing. (See...I Screamed, "Stay in Line" ch 4.)
