

The Great Change (The difference between Mal. 4 & Rev. 10) Part #2

The reason that the change was so important to the bride is that without understanding who is actually the Angel for this hour, you will not be able to leave the 7th Church Age and step into the 8th Day. The messenger of Malachi 4 could only turn the hearts of the Children to the fathers by preaching the restored word of God. The Angel of Revelation 10 was to literally turn the hearts of the children back to the fathers. That literal turning is the new birth for this hour that we are living in. It is not enough to come out of the denominational system and come to the message of the hour and say that William Branham is the prophet, but unless you meet the Mighty Angel of Revelation 10:1 you still are not ready to be born again. It takes the revealing of the 7 thunders to you personally by the Mighty Angel to give you an understanding.

Many people in the denominational systems fail to see the importance of coming out of the system and following the message that has been given for this hour, but there are those who came to follow the message of the hour (Moses) and failed to follow the messenger which was to follow Moses... Joshua.

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57 020 Joshua here is a Book; actually it's a Book of redemption, of the Old Testament. Joshua, we would have to consider it to be that, the Book of redemption. Because it's... Redemption has two parts. Redemption anywhere has two parts. That is, it's "out of" and "into." It takes two parts to make redemption, "out of," "into."

Moses represented the law which brought them out of Egypt, and whereas, Joshua represented grace that took them into the promised land. Another way was, the--the law and grace were two different aspects of God's command. Now, the law brought them out, Moses, and Joshua took them in.

It also represents something for our day. Now, it represents, as they were in the journey, coming from--from Egypt into a promised land, so have we come out of a world of Egypt, chaos, on our road to a promised land. "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it wasn't so, I would've told you," John 14: coming "out of," going "into."
